The most recognizable songs from all of the biggest Broadway shows will fill the Cole Auditorium later this month as part of the DeWitt Performing Arts Series. *Neil Berg's 100 Years of Broadway* will feature songs that everyone will recognize from dozens of Broadway's biggest shows on Tuesday, January 31, at 7:30 p.m. at The Robert L. & Elizabeth S. Cole Auditorium at Richmond Community College.

The greatest moments from the finest shows of the last 100 years are re-created with the songs being sung by performers that have performed the songs on the stages of Broadway. The singers are accompanied by an all-star New York band.

Auditorium Director Joey Bennett said that the show features music from a wide-variety of shows. "The show has a great cross-section of Broadway shows represented; from the classics like *Show Boat* and *Kiss Me, Kate*, to contemporary shows like *Jersey Boys* and *Grease*. Almost everyone's favorite Broadway shows will be represented."

The show was created and co-produced by Neil Berg, whose impressive resume includes work with well-known talents such as Ben Vereen and Bernadette Peters. His credits include composer and lyricist for several musicals. Berg also serves as musical director and pianist for the show.
